

INTRODUCTION TO CRUDE OIL

Course Description

This course will teach you the Crude Oil process through an on-line education course developed by the COLC Education Awareness Sub-committee under the COLC umbrella. You will get an educational overview and gain an understanding of the end-to-end Crude Logistics process.

At the end of this course you will have learned about:

- The various components of the exploration process, including the land purchase process, what royalties are and how to find land or well locations
- Drilling and completion of oil wells, single and multi-well production fields and the function and significance of pump jacks and batteries
- Mode of transportation, types of pipelines and terminals and product types
- The forecasting process from Forms A, B and C to purchase / sale transactions and deliveries
- Nomination submissions and understanding the timeliness and accuracy requirements
- Monthly settlements – including production splits, shipper balance and the accrual process

Course Structure

This is a 5 module on-line course with knowledge checks and a final exam with a 70% pass requirement.

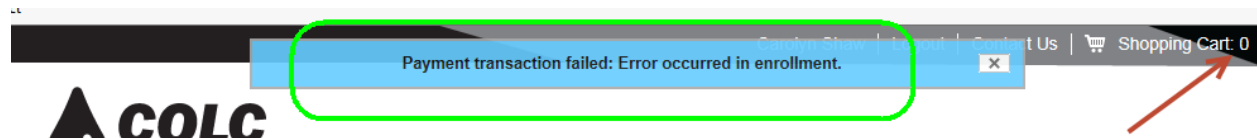
